- *Vehicle registration is the only acceptable proof of residency.
- Bicyclists and walk-ins are admitted to the park free of charge.
- Rochester Hills Annual City Park Permits and Senior/Handicap Passes allow vehicle entry to Spencer, Bloomer, and Yates Parks.
- Handicap/Senior Park Passes are also available at Rochester Hills City Hall Treasury Department during normal business hours.

Spencer Park Amenities

- Bass Tournament
- Lifeguarded beach with wading area
- Fishing (DNR regulations apply)
- Rowboat and paddle boat rentals
- Handicap-accessible fishing pier, boat launch, and beach
- Charcoal grills and picnic tables
- Playground
- Nature paths – 3 miles wooded
- Volleyball court and tennis courts
- Concession stand

During winter months, the park is open subject to safe ice conditions, which can be checked by visiting our website at www.rochesterhills.org/Spencer or calling 248-656-4657.

- * Ice skating – separate maintained areas for open skating and hockey (no equipment rental)

- * Heated shelter with fireplace and restrooms

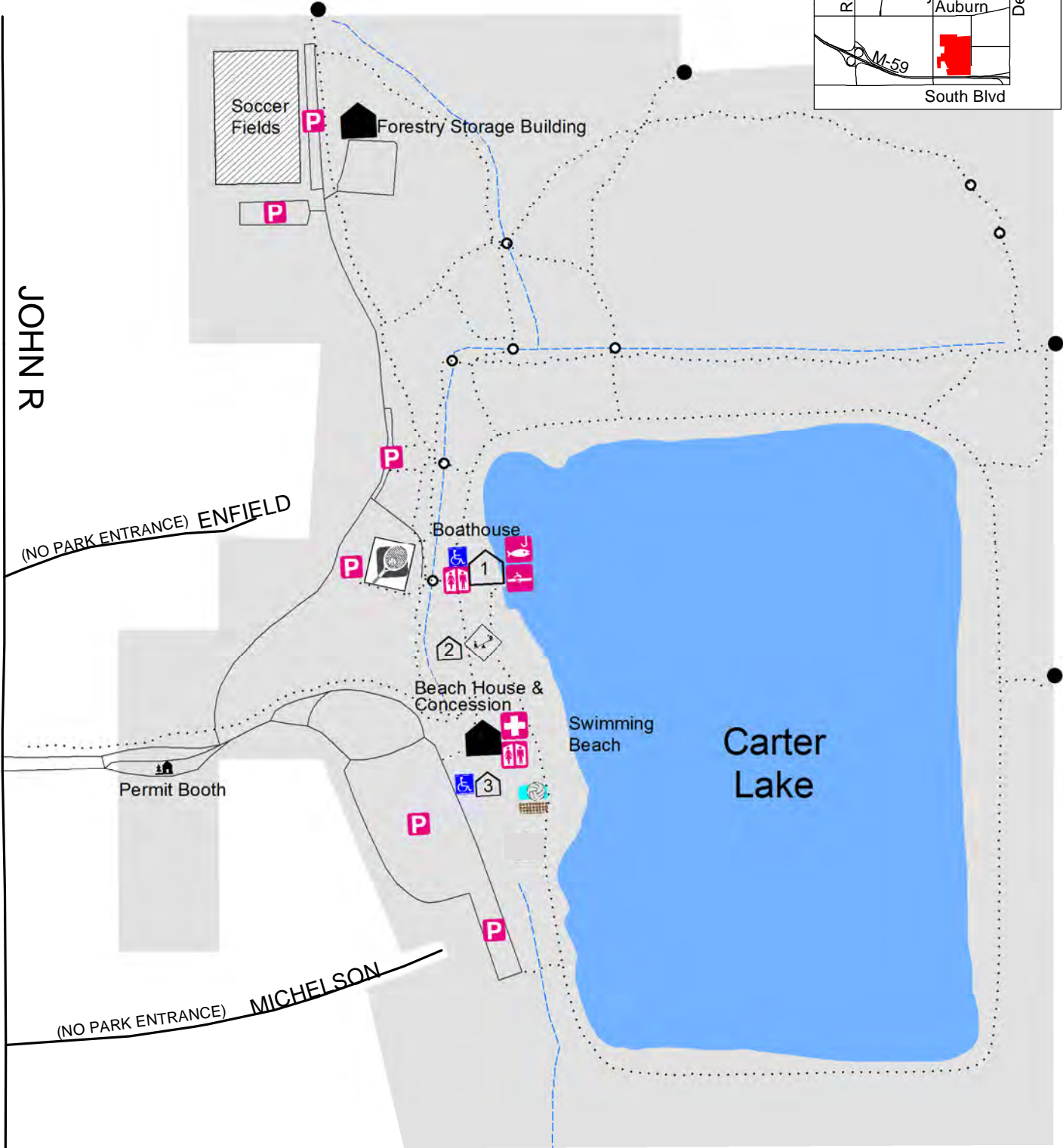
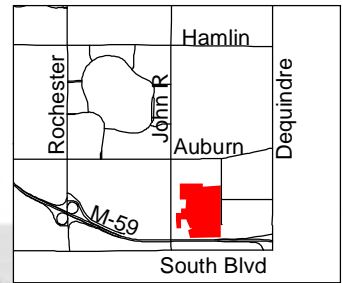
Shelter	\$200/day
Tents (2)	\$100 each/day

- Shelter reservable May through mid-November.
- Tents reservable Memorial Day through Labor Day weekends.
- Shelter prices do not include vehicle entry fees.
- Shelter includes seven 8-foot cafeteria tables, a charcoal grill, and electrical service.
- Each tent includes eight 6-foot picnic tables, and no electrical service.
- Restroom facilities in the shelter are open to the general public at all times.
- Decorations must be removed completely at the end of your event, with no damage to the property.
- Park management must approve all special arrangements not considered part of an average picnic prior to the reservation date.
- Vehicles cannot be driven to shelter or tents.

Rules and Regulations (For a complete listing, please visit our website at www.rochesterhills.org/Parks)

1. A City of Rochester Hills Park Permit is required for entry of all motor vehicles. Annual permits must be permanently attached to the windshield. Permits are nontransferable.
2. **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited within the park.**
3. Speed limit within the park is 15 mph.
4. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and must be attended while in the swimming area.
5. Visitors must abide by posted rules.
6. The use of firearms or weapons is strictly prohibited.
7. NO pets allowed inside the park.
8. NO flotation devices of any kind are permitted in Carter Lake.
9. NO trailers, boats (other than those rented by the park), or snowmobiles.
10. NO ground fires.
11. NO destruction of property, natural surroundings, or wildlife.
12. NO disorderly conduct or behavior that disturbs others.
13. NO fireworks.

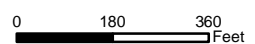
M-59 (NO PARK ENTRANCE)
