


# State Shared Revenue



State-shared revenue represents the share of sales tax collections by the State which are distributed to the City based (in part) on the City's population on a prorated basis.

Indicator Score = Yellow/Same 

## TREND ANALYSIS:

Sales tax fluctuations vary depending on the strength of the state economy, actual sales tax revenue, and annual appropriation bills for the statutory portion. This is evidenced by the decrease of actual disbursements in state shared revenue by nearly \$1.3 million from 2003-2010. The increase in revenue between 2010-2015 is the result of both our growth in population from the 2010 census (2.9% increase) and growth in sales tax revenue at the state level. The increase in the City's population helped the City share more in this allocation.
