Amur Maackia (Maackia amurensis)

Origin: Seed-grown (except cultivars), native to northeast Asia

Mature Size: Medium (25-35' tall)

Description: Amur Maackia is a medium-size flowering tree with a relatively slow rate of growth and rounded form. It prefers well-drained soil, but is tolerant to a wide range of environmental conditions. It has no serious disease or pest problems. The bark has an attractive olive-green to golden-brown color, and leaves turn yellow in fall. Racemes of small white flowers usually appear in July. Improved varieties are currently being produced and should be available soon: 'Starburst', SummertimeTM.
