Triumph™ Hybrid Elm (*Ulmus japonica x pumila x wilsoniana*)

Origin: Morton Arboretum (IL), parent trees native to Asia

Mature Size: Large (>45' tall)

Description: Triumph™ elm was selected for its upright form (vase-shaped at maturity), fast growth rate, and environmental tolerance. It is known to be resistant to Dutch Elm Disease and elm leaf beetle, although it is susceptible to elm leaf miner. Its leaves (smaller than American elm) are glossy dark green and often turn yellow in the fall. It has a relatively aggressive root system and should not be planted near sidewalks. Triumph™ elm tends to grow taller and more upright than Accolade™ elm. Fall color is yellow.
